With RAR book bags children learn to:
Follow classroom rules and routines

With RAR books, children:
Realize that symbols represent sounds and words
Understand and use increasingly complex vocabulary
Use language – English and Spanish - to communicate, to ask and answer questions.
Understand print concepts
Develop phonemic awareness
